on or about the *first* day of *February* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *eighty-two* and is now about *21* years years of age; that he arrived at *Ellis Island*

in the District of *New York* in the United States of America, on or about the *fourth* day of *June* in the year of our Lord one thousand *nine* hundred and *three* ; that it then was,

and still is, his bona fide intention to become a citizen of the United States of America, and to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to every foreign Prince, State, Potentate and Sovereignty whatsoever,—more especially to Edward VII., King of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland,

whose subject he has heretofore been. He therefore prays, that his said Declaration and Intention may become a record of said Court, agreeably to the laws in such case made and provided.

Whereupon the Declaration of the said Petitioner is admitted to become a record of said Court accordingly. as appears of record in said Court

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the seal of said Court at Boston, in said District, *this eighth day of September A. D. 1909.* the day and year first above written, and in the one hundred and *thirty-fourth* year of the Independence of the United States of America.
