

This information is for Alton Berg (Jim) Beckstead.


My dad intended for our genealogy to simply include the Shiloff's and Zoorwill's, but this information IMHO should also be reflected since my cousins and I regarded Jim as "Grandpa Jim".

I had no idea he had a first wife!

Grandpa Jim owned an auto shop with her brother, which surprised me, as he still co-owned it 10 years after her death. It was called Beckstead & Durfee, and was on the corner of Pearl and Girard in La Jolla. I found it listed in several places as "G. W. Durfee", but from Family Search saw this was her brother Glen Willis Durfee.

I'm simply going to place the information on this page as a way to not forget that I found this. My dad is getting older and won't always remember this, and quite frankly nor will I.

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I also included a picture of Grandpa Jim's headstone. My grandmother worked a variety of jobs; one of them was selling cemetery plots. She bought two of them and always intended for she and Jim to be buried together regardless of what the future held. When Grandma Mollie died we held a graveside service at Eternal Hills where she had the plots, my mother pointed out this was the Jewish area of the cemetery and low and behold, Grandma Mollie had a Star of David on top of Jim's headstone. Apparently no one had noticed this before. Religion didn't matter much to either one of them but I guess she affiliated most with being Jewish.
