MEMORANDUM OF CONTINUANCES PETITION FOR NATURALIZATION

Honorable the Justice of the Peace Northampton County, Som
 The petition of Meyer Shiloff hereby filed, respectfully sheweth
 First. My place of residence is 818 West 25th Street, Somers, Conn.
 Second. My occupation is Merchant
 Third. I was born on the 10th day of February, anno Domini 1882, at Arusha, Russian
 Fourth. I emigrated to the United States from Arusha, Russian on or about the 5th day of June
1903, and arrived in the United States at the port of Ellis Island, N.Y. on the 14th day of June
1903, on the vessel Frankland
 (If the alien arrived otherwise than by vessel, the character of conveyance or mode of transportation should be given.)
 I declared my intention to become a citizen of the United States on the 10th day of September, anno Domini 1903
 at Dorset, Massachusetts in the District Court of the United States, Massachusetts
 I am not married. My wife's name is Serthe Shiloff she was born
Mankowsky, Russian and now resides at 818 West 25th Street, Somers, Conn.
 I have two children, and the name, date and place of birth, and place of residence of each of said children is as follows:

Yman Shiloff born March 19th 1909. Irvoche Shiloff born November 18th 1910.
Rich born at and now reside at Somers, Conn.

Second. I am not a disbeliever in or opposed to organized government or a member of or affiliated with any organization or body of persons teaching disbelief in or opposed to organized government. I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy. I am attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and it is my intention to become a citizen of the United States and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and fidelity to Nicholas II Emperor of all the Russias of whom at this time I am a subject, and it is my intention to reside permanently in the United States.

Eighth. I am able to speak the English language.
 Ninth. I have resided continuously in the United States of America for the term of five years at least, immediately preceding the date of this petition, to wit, since the 4th day of June, anno Domini 1903, and in the State of Som, continuously since preceding the date of this petition, since the 22nd day of December, anno Domini 1901, being a residence within this State of at least one year next preceding the date of this petition.

Tenth. I have not heretofore made petition for citizenship to any court. I made petition for citizenship to the Justice of the Peace on the 10th day of September, anno Domini 1903, and the order of such court has since been affirmed and confirmed.

Attached hereto and made a part of this petition are my declaration of intention to become a citizen of the United States and the certificate of the Department of Commerce and Labor, together with my affidavits and the affidavits of the two verifying witnesses thereto, required by law. Wherefore your petitioner prays that he may be admitted a citizen of the United States of America.
