Myer Shiloff, 81, 134 Cook Drive, retired grocer, died Tuesday in a Sioux City hospital after a long illness.

Mr. Shiloff was born in Russia, Feb. 1, 1886, and came to the United States and to Sioux City in 1907. He operated grocery stores at several locations until his retirement ten years ago. He married Gertrude Glick in Sioux City in 1908. She died March 29, 1960. He was a member of Shaare Zion Synagogue.
